A picturesque market town known for its mistletoe market, hops and highstreet food shops.



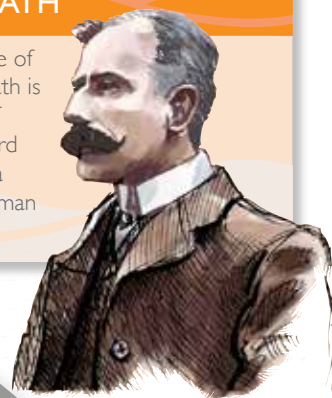
BROMYARD

Set in rolling countryside, this is a market town with a difference! Among it's many attractions you'll find Daleks and Joe Ninety Thunderbirds puppets.



BROADHEATH

The pretty village of Lower Broadheath is the birthplace of composer Edward Elgar and hosts a museum to the man and his music.



Each location featured on the leisure drive will also have a tried and tested (moderate level) walk or cycle route nearby.

MARTLEY

Martley's St Peter's Church still has some amazing ancient wall paintings including: stags, rabbits, hunting scenes and even fire-breathing dragons!



GT. WITLEY

Near Witley's famous Hall sits Abberley Hill and it's panoramic views. Also nearby is the Hill Climb track at Shelsley Walsh, one of Britain's oldest race venues.



CLEOBURY MORTIMER

Cleobury's St Mary's Church has a rare twisted spire and is surrounded by picturesque countryside and the pretty little River Rea - home to an array of wildlife including Kingfishers.
